## DEEP WELCOMES SHOPMOBILTY'S 1000th CUSTOMER

The Deep, Hull's £45.5m Millennium Commission lottery project is welcoming Shopmobility's 1000<sup>th</sup> customer on Wednesday October 6th. To help celebrate, The Deep will give the 1000th user, Mr John Cook a family ticket to the attraction, when he makes a special journey from Princes Quay to The Deep.

Shopmobility provides electric scooters and wheelchairs to help people with restricted mobility to get around shops, offices, and tourist attractions in Hull City Council. Current members are aged 10 years to 90.

The Hull Shopmobility scheme is based in a purpose built unit in Princes Quay Shopping Centre. It has been run entirely on a voluntary basis run directly by the charity Kingston upon Hull Shopmobility Ltd. Since reopening in December 2003, it has been used 1000 times by its members.

Cllr Danny Brown, chair of Kingston upon Hull Shopmobility Ltd explains,

"As a charity Shopmobility has striven long and hard to get this scheme up and running. In this we have had strong support from Princes Quay and from our own volunteers. I am delighted that we have reached the landmark of 1000<sup>th</sup> user in only nine months since the charity took over the running of the scheme. This proves very clearly what an excellent service it is, and how much it is needed by local people and visitors who have restricted mobility. Without the scheme it would be difficult, and in some cases impossible, for people to visit the many attractions and facilities of Hull City centre, including that magnificent, award-winning attraction The Deep. I am particularly pleased that The Deep has offered a family ticket to Mr Cook and his family as our 1000<sup>th</sup> user , and look forward to an even busier period now that the Christmas shopping season is almost upon us."
